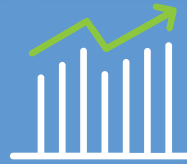

Eliminate human error and manual data entry by automatically collecting data



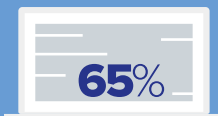
36% **Approvals**
